

CHANGE IN GROUP/SUBJECT/s

(A) Middle & Secondary School Examination:

A student may be permitted by Heads of the institution to change his/her subject till the last date of submission of the examination forms to the Board.

The attendance in the case of a student allowed to change his/her subjects under these regulations shall be counted from the date of change

There-after requests for the change of subjects may be made to the Board's office upto the last date along with fee as decided by the Board from time to time. The Assistant Secretary concerned shall be the authority competent to grant permission in such cases provided that such applications are received along with prescribed fee and a certificate from the Head of Institution to the effect that the candidate has been studying the subject throughout the semester. In case of private candidates/Ex-student the decision to allow change of subject shall be taken by the Secretary considering the merits of the case.

After the scheduled date no application/request will be entertained/considered.

(B) Senior Secondary Certificate School Examination:

Generally a candidate will not be permitted to change his group/subject of study after passing class 11th but if head of the institution deems fit he/she can be allowed change of stream till the last date of submission of examination form to the Board from Science to Commerce/Humanity or Commerce to Humanities or change in subject/s in the same stream.

There-after requests for correction in the examination form may be made to the Board's office upto the last date alongwith fee as decided by the Board from time to time. The Assistant Secretary concerned shall be the authority competent to grant permission in such cases provided that such applications are received alongwith prescribed fee and certificate from the Head of institution to the effect that the candidate has been studying the subject throughout the semester. In

case of private candidates//Ex-student the decision to allow change of subject shall be taken by the Secretary considering the merits of the case.

After the schedule date no application/request will be entertained/considered.
