Note:

- i) Every candidate shall have to opt for:
 - One subject out of Third Languages Group (Sr. No. 3) and
 - One elective subject out of the subjects shown at Sr. No. 7.
- ii) Deaf and Dumb, Dyslexic and Spastic candidates shall be exempted from third language.
- iii) A blind candidate shall be exempted from practical examination except in music and in the case of such exemption, the marks in theory papers shall be proportionately increased. Blind students will not be allowed to opt for drawing as a subject of study.
- iv) Blind candidates shall be exempted from Geometry part of Mathematics and the marks in Algebra part shall proportionately be increased.
- v) Participation in co-curricular activities and the level of efficiency attained therein will be recognized and rewarded by way of enhancement in the overall GPA up to a maximum of 2% as well as in the aggregate percentage.
